

INFORMATION OBLIGATION OF THE DATA CONTROLLER

In accordance with the Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation) **GDPR** we would like to inform you that:

The Data Controller of your personal data processed for the purpose of responding to your inquiries and providing you with product and service information is Hycom S.A. with headquarters located at Piramowicza 11/13, 90 254 Łódź, entered in the register of entrepreneurs of the National Court Register by the District Court for the City of ŁÓDŹ ŚRÓDMIEŚCIE IN ŁÓDŹ, XX Commercial Division under KRS number: 0000561064, NIP: 7252087369, REGON: 361651723.

We process your personal data, i.e. e-mail address, name, surname, telephone number, voice, image, on the basis of your voluntary consent to provide product and service information, including its availability and further updates. In addition, in order to document your consent, we collect the data and information from your computer system, i.e. IP address, location.

We will process the above-mentioned data on the basis of the consent given (Article 6(1)(a) of the GDPR) until its withdrawal or the cessation of the processing. After this time, we may also process your data for the defense of claims based on our legitimate interest (Article 6(1)(f) of the GDPR) for the period specified by law, i.e. 6 years. This means that we will keep and secure only the data that will be necessary to prove the facts regarding possible investigation or to defend against claims.

We use Hubspot, an external CRM provider, to obtain and collect your data. All data submitted is transferred and stored within the European Economic Area. In exceptional cases, however, it may be transferred to third countries in accordance with the applicable European regulations on the protection of personal data. Your personal data may also be transferred to business partners and suppliers working with us. In addition, we may transfer your data to companies that are authorized to obtain data on the basis of applicable law, e.g. courts or law enforcement authorities, if they submit a request based on a corresponding legal basis.

You have the right to access your data, including obtaining a copy of it, rectifying data, requesting its deletion, restriction of processing, objecting to processing and transferring the data provided (the processing of which you have consented) to another data controller. You also have the right to lodge a complaint with the President of the Personal Data Protection Office. Withdrawal of consent does not affect the lawfulness of processing that had been carried out on the basis of consent before its withdrawal.
